Freda has been actively involved on the Executive of Nutana LBC for most of her 12 years of membership. She chaired the Marketing/Publicity Committee for several years and was instrumental in developing the use of the "Go Lawn Bowl" branding initiative at the club. She helps coach the Learn to Bowl sessions and, presently, is the President of the club. In her capacity as president she has proceeded with the development of a Procedures manual for all aspects of committee work at the club. A number of major initiatives to increase membership and improve the club have taken place during her presidency. The interior of the clubhouse has been painted and almost completely refurbished and the backboard and plinths have been replaced through a \$24,000 grant from the Recreational Infrastructure program of the Federal Government. The club successfully hosted the National Juniors tournament and World Cup Qualifier during her first year as president. The club has been quite successful in obtaining grants for programs to increase membership and to raise the profile of Lawn Bowling in Saskatoon. Freda has ensured the club environment and executive attention to these initiatives has been such that the club has been very successful with membership increases and grant funding.
